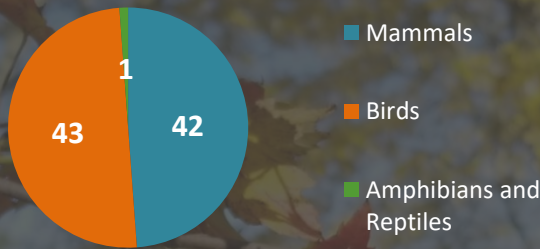




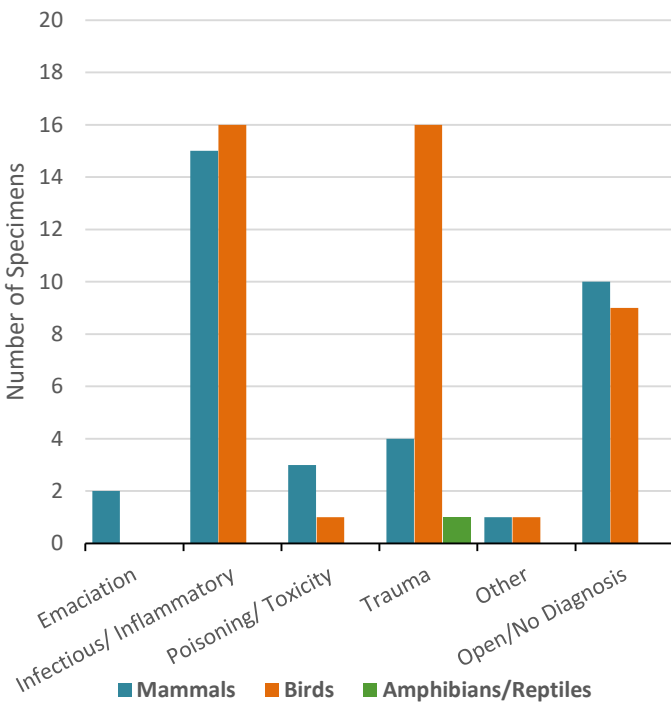

TESTED	POSITIVE	NOTES
AVIAN INFLUENZA VIRUS - DEAD BIRD SURVEILLANCE		
10	0 Matrix Positive 0 H5 Positive 0 H7 Positive	None of the birds tested for AIV were positive by Matrix PCR.
WEST NILE VIRUS		
11	3	Three of the birds tested for West Nile Virus were positive by PCR, all from Raptors.
CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE		
11	0	None of the cervids tested positive for CWD by ELISA testing.
AVIAN AVULAVIRUS (PARAMYXOVIRUS-1)		
3	0	There were 0 positive cases of Avian Avulavirus (NewCastle Disease).
RABIES		
14	3	There were 3 Big Brown Bats confirmed positive for Rabies by the CFIA.
CANINE DISTEMPER VIRUS		
9	5	There were 5 positive cases of Canine Distemper Virus in 4 Raccoons and 1 Skunk.
SALMONELLA		
6	5	There were 5 positive cases of Salmonella found in 4 Sparrows and 1 Cardinal.

NOTE: Animals reported represent the data currently available in the CWHC database and should be considered preliminary. These data do not include all diagnostic testing for the selected pathogens carried out in Ontario. Additional testing is performed by other agencies and organizations.
